## Engaging the World

34% of this graduating class studied off campus at some point during their undergraduate years (n=125)

34% of this graduating class studied abroad during their undergraduate years (n=125)

25% of men (39/159) and 41% of women (86/212) studied abroad

37% of students of color (28/76); 32% of international graduates (13/41) and 26% of first-generation graduates studied abroad (12/46)

20% of science majors studied abroad (21/105); 24% of athletes studied abroad (24/102)

3 students participated in off campus study programs in the United States, such as the Washington Center Internship Program

2% of graduates participated in a Mosaic or Globally Integrated Course. Areas of study included climate change, human security, the arts, natural history, sustainability, cultural migrations, leadership and human resources, and public health and disasters response (n=7)

4 graduating seniors has been awarded a Fulbright this year; 1 informed the college they have accepted a position as a teacher with Teach for America, 1 joined the Peace Corps and 5
