

GUIDELINES FOR DOCUMENTATION OF **HOUSING ACCOMMODATION REQUESTS** ON THE BASIS OF A PSYCHIATRIC/PSYCHOLOGICAL DISABILITY

Dickinson College students who seek accommodations based on their disability are responsible for completing an online form (through www.dickinson.edu/access), and for providing appropriate supporting documentation. Dickinson College approaches requests for accommodations with the belief that each student's circumstance is unique and that a flexible approach is the right way to determine appropriate accommodations.
